These extra trains will operate between Chicago, IL and Quincy/Bloomington-Normal, IL and serve stations as indicated.

### Service on Illinois Route Trains

- Coaches: Reservations required.**
- Business class:** Ticket price includes non-alcoholic beverage and newspaper, and access to the Amtrak Metropolitan Lounge in Chicago.
- Cafe:** Sandwiches, snacks and beverages.
- Checked baggage at select stations.
- Wi-Fi available.
- Unboxed Bicycles and Golf Bags:** A limited number of spaces are available to transport unboxed bicycles and golf bags to/from all stations. Reservations are required; nominal charges apply; passenger assists with loading, stowing and unloading.
- Passengers not carried locally between this station and Chicago except when connecting at Chicago to/from other Amtrak trains.

All Amtrak services and stations are non-smoking.

Service is financed primarily through funds made available by the Illinois Department of Transportation.

### Airport Connections

#### Chicago Airports

Chicago Transit Authority (CTA) rapid transit trains provide frequent service to O'Hare and Midway Airports. Blue Line trains to O'Hare leave from the subway station at the corner of Clinton and Congress Streets, two blocks south of Union Station. Orange Line trains to Midway leave from the elevated station at the corner of Quincy and Wells streets, three blocks east of Union Station. Pay fare in CTA station.
