-  Free shuttle service between rail and air terminal.
-  This station is operated by VIA Rail Canada. Trains between Niagara Falls, ON and Toronto are operated by VIA Rail Canada in cooperation with Amtrak. Through fares/ticketing available.
-  U.S. Customs and Border Protection inspection. Train is subject to delay.
-  Not a passenger stop; Canadian Customs and Immigration inspection only. Train is subject to delay.
-  Seasonal stop only on dates of ferry operation. Lake Champlain Transportation Company ferries operate summer service between Port Kent on the *Adirondack* route, and downtown Burlington, Vermont. - \* Connecting Train 150 operates Saturday and Sunday and departs Washington, DC at 3:15 a.m.; connecting Train 110 operates Monday through Friday and departs Washington, DC at 4:00 a.m. and arrives New York at 7:22 a.m.

## CROSSING THE U.S./CANADIAN BORDER Customs and Immigration Information

If you are crossing the border by land or sea, including on Amtrak trains and Thruway services, you must have one secure Western Hemisphere Travel Initiative-compliant document that proves both citizenship and identity.

- For United States citizens 16 or over, this document must be one of the following: passport, passport card, trusted traveler card (NEXUS, SENTRI or FAST), enhanced driver's license, merchant mariner document, US military ID with military orders, or form I-872 (American Indian card).
- For Canadian citizens, this document must be one of the following: passport, trusted traveler card, or enhanced driver's licence.
- For citizens of other countries, a passport, and in many cases a visa, are required.
- A passenger 15 and younger who does not have one of the above may present a copy of his or her birth certificate instead.

For further information and to determine what is required for your particular situation (including permanent residents and others not mentioned above), contact the appropriate US or Canadian government agencies prior to travel.

An Amtrak brochure with additional details, "Important Information on Crossing the Border between the United States and Canada", is available. Ask for it from an Amtrak agent.

### Other details:

- Passengers under 18 not traveling with both parents require a letter from any parent not present giving permission to cross the border. If one parent is deceased, bringing a copy of the death certificate will minimize questioning and delay at the border. Children under 18 may not cross the US-Canadian border unaccompanied. Exception: A child 16 or 17 may cross the border unaccompanied if he or she is returning to the country of which he or she is a citizen. Example: A 17 year old child who is a citizen of Canada may return to Montreal unaccompanied.
- Amtrak and VIA Rail Canada will require your date of birth, your country of citizenship, and your identification information. This will be entered into your reservation record and provided to border authorities. If you do not provide this information we are unable to accept payment or issue your ticket.
- Admission into either country is solely at the discretion of border authorities, and possession of required documentation and the provision of required information in no way guarantees entry. Neither Amtrak nor VIA Rail Canada nor any other carrier is in any way liable if you are denied entry or removed from the train or bus.

## PASSAGE DE LA FRONTIÈRE ÉTATS-UNIS/CANADA

### Renseignements sur les douanes et l'immigration

Si vous traversez la frontière par voie terrestre ou maritime, incluant par train Amtrak et par les services d'autobus Thruway, vous devez avoir en votre possession un document de l'Initiative relative aux voyages dans l'hémisphère occidental des États-Unis qui prouve votre citoyenneté et votre identité.

- Pour les citoyens américains de 16 ans et plus, les documents suivants sont acceptés : un passeport, une carte-passeport, une carte pour les voyageurs dignes de confiance (NEXUS, SENTRI ou FAST), un permis de conduire Plus, un document de la marine marchande, une carte d'identité militaire américaine avec des ordres de mission ou le formulaire I-872 (carte d'Amérindien).
- Pour les citoyens canadiens, les documents suivants sont acceptés : un passeport, une carte pour les voyageurs dignes de confiance ou un permis de conduire Plus.
- Pour les citoyens des autres pays, un passeport et, dans de nombreux cas, un visa sont exigés.
- Il est permis aux passagers de 15 ans et moins qui ne possèdent pas l'un des documents ci-dessus d'utiliser un exemplaire de leur certificat de naissance.

Pour obtenir plus de renseignements et pour connaître les documents requis selon votre situation (y compris les résidents permanents et autres cas non mentionnés ci-dessus), veuillez communiquer avec les agences gouvernementales canadiennes ou américaines avant votre départ.

Vous trouverez également plus de détails dans cette brochure Amtrak : « Renseignements important pour traverser la frontière entre les États-Unis et le Canada ». Demandez-la à un agent Amtrak.

#### Autres détails :

- Un passager de 18 ans et moins qui n'est pas accompagné de ses deux parents doit avoir en sa possession une lettre d'autorisation de chaque parent absent afin de traverser la frontière. En cas de décès de l'un des deux parents, le certificat de décès permettra d'éviter une interrogation et des délais à la frontière. Les enfants de 18 ans et moins ne peuvent pas traverser la frontière États-Unis/Canada sans être accompagnés. Exception : un enfant de 16 ou 17 ans peut traverser la frontière seul s'il retourne dans son pays d'origine. Par exemple, un enfant de 17 ans de nationalité canadienne peut retourner à Montréal sans être accompagné.
- Amtrak et VIA Rail Canada exigeront que vous fournissiez votre date de naissance, votre nationalité et vos renseignements d'identification. Ces renseignements seront consignés dans votre dossier de réservation et seront transmis aux autorités frontalières. Sans ces renseignements, nous ne pourrions pas accepter votre paiement ou émettre votre billet.
- L'admission à l'un des deux pays est à l'unique discrétion des autorités frontalières. Le fait d'avoir en votre possession les documents requis et de fournir les renseignements exigés ne garantit d'aucune façon l'entrée au pays. Amtrak, VIA Rail Canada ni aucun autre transporteur ne peut être tenu responsable si votre entrée est refusée ou si vous êtes contraint à descendre du train ou de l'autobus.
