Passengers traveling to/from Sacramento will be ticketed at Sacramento. All standard discounts are available. Adult passengers between Lake Tahoe and Placerville may buy a ticket from the driver for \$20.00 cash fare each way. Children are half price and no other discounts apply.

**Transit Transfers and Discounted Travel on Local Transit**

- Connections to local transit with Capitol Corridor Transit Transfer Ticket (ask conductor for two free transfers) – Ride free on East Bay AC Transit buses, Contra Costa County Connection, Sacramento RT buses and light rail, e-Tran, Rio Vista Delta Breeze, WestCAT, Yolobus, UC Davis Unitrans, Santa Clara VTA light rail and buses, Fairfield-Suisun Transit and Tri Delta Transit. Transfer is valid through the following day.
- 20% Discount on BART tickets – In our Café Car, buy a \$10 value ticket for just \$8, and ride BART from the Richmond Intermodal Station or Oakland Coliseum Station to San Francisco International Airport and other destinations throughout the SF Bay Area. Limit one per customer.
- SFMTA Tokens (Muni) – Buy a \$2 token to ride Muni to many spots in San Francisco. Limit two per customer.

*BART to OAK*, BART's new train to plane service, operates between the BART Coliseum station and Oakland International Airport. Three car automated people movers operate when BART is open, avoiding all traffic. The ride takes eight minutes and service is frequent throughout the day. Amtrak passengers may take BART to OAK by transferring at the adjacent Amtrak Oakland Coliseum station. Separate fare applies, paid at the BART station.
