INFRASTRUCTURE RENEWAL AT NY PENN STATION

Amtrak is making a series of major infrastructure upgrades that will improve New York Penn Station's operational performance and reliability. This program will require extensive track work, which will impact train service. While this will create some impacts on service levels this summer, it will compress work that might take years into a period of weeks and, in the end, give us brand new infrastructure in a critical part of the station that will be more reliable and require less disruptive maintenance for years to come – benefitting all users of the station including our commuter partners at Long Island Rail Road (LIRR) and NJ TRANSIT (NJT).

The Crescent, Trains 19 and 20, originate and terminate at Washington D.C. and will not operate between Washington and New York. Train 19 will operate approximately 1 hour and 25 minutes later than the usual schedule; Train 20 will be approximately 13 minutes later arriving at Washington D.C. These temporary changes apply to Train 20, originating at New Orleans beginning July 9.

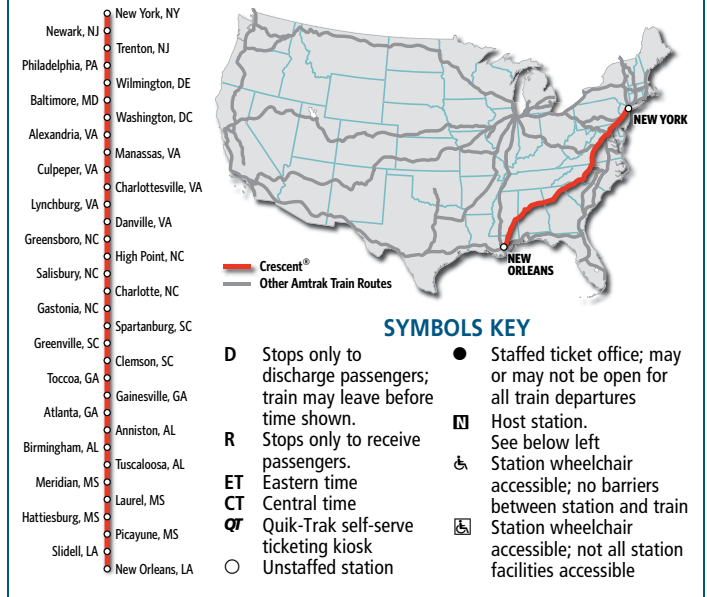

- R Coaches: Reservations required.**
- B Business class:** Seating in dedicated car, two bottles of water, Wi-Fi access and entrance to Amtrak ClubAcela First class Lounge in New York, Philadelphia and Washington, DC and Magnolia Room in New Orleans.
- Sleeping cars:** Viewliner sleeping accommodations. - Amtrak ClubAcela First class Lounge available in New York, Philadelphia and Washington, DC, and the Magnolia Room in New Orleans for Sleeping car passengers.
- Dining:** Full meal service.
- Lounge:** Sandwiches, snacks and beverages.
- Checked baggage** at select stations.

- Trains 19 and 20: trainside checked bicycle service offered between staffed locations handling checked baggage.
