Trails and Rails Program: In cooperation with the National Park Service, volunteer rangers provide narrative on select trains.

- Rangers from the Fort Union Trading Post National Historic Site between Williston and Shelby, Tuesdays and Saturdays, between June 1 and September 11; and,
- Rangers from the Knife River Indian Villages Historic Site between Minot and Shelby, Thursdays and Fridays, between May 23 and September 5, and between Minot and Malta, Sundays, between May 23 and September 5.
