Empire Service trains operating west/north of Albany offer sandwiches, snacks and beverages. Some trains offer Quiet cars, Business class, Sleeping car and Dining service.

- R Coaches:** All reserved train/connecting train. Reserved seat ticket required for boarding.
- B Business class:** Complimentary non-alcoholic beverages (on select trains) and newspaper.
- S Sleeping cars:** Reservations required.
- D Dining:** Complete meals.
- C Cafe:** Sandwiches, snacks and beverages.
- C Checked baggage:** Checked baggage at select stations.
- W Wi-Fi:** Available.
- T This station is operated by VIA Rail Canada.** Trains between Niagara Falls, ON and Toronto are operated by VIA Rail Canada in cooperation with Amtrak. Through fares/ticketing available.
- Ft. Edward:** is 38 miles and Saratoga Springs is 19 miles from Schenectady via the Adirondack/Ethan Allen Express routes.
- TrainCatcher:** van/car service available from Ft. Edward to Glens Falls and Lake George Village. Reservations required. Call (518) 792-1086 for information and reservations.
