- R Coaches:** All reserved train/connecting train. Reserved seat ticket required for boarding.
- B Business class:** Ticket price includes non-alcoholic beverages (on select trains) and newspaper.
- S Sleeping cars:** Reservations required.
- X Dining:** Complete meals.
- C Cafe:** Sandwiches, snacks and beverages.
- C Checked baggage:** Checked baggage at select stations.
- Wi-Fi:** Wi-Fi available.
- 11:** This station is operated by VIA Rail Canada. Trains between Niagara Falls, ON and Toronto are operated by VIA Rail Canada in cooperation with Amtrak. Through fares/ticketing available.
- 13:** Ft. Edward is 38 miles and Saratoga Springs is 19 miles from Schenectady via the Adirondack/Ethan Allen Express routes.
