Service on Empire Service®

Empire Service trains operating west/north of Albany offer sandwiches, snacks and beverages. Some trains offer Quiet cars, Business class, Sleeping car and Dining service.

- Coaches:** All reserved train/connecting train. Reserved seat ticket required for boarding.
- Business class:** Ticket price includes non-alcoholic beverages (on select trains) and newspaper.
- Sleeping cars:** Reservations required.
- Dining:** Complete meals.
- Café:** Sandwiches, snacks and beverages.
- Checked baggage at select stations.
- Wi-Fi available.
- Trains 448 and 449 trainside checked bicycle service offered between staffed locations handling checked baggage. Customers will check in with the station agent, get a claim check/baggage tag for their bike, and hand up to a crew member inside the baggage car. Visit Amtrak.com/bikes for more information.
- This station is operated by VIA Rail Canada. Trains between Niagara Falls, ON and Toronto are operated by VIA Rail Canada in cooperation with Amtrak. Through fares/ticketing available.
- Ft. Edward is 38 miles and Saratoga Springs is 19 miles from Schenectady via the *Adirondack/Ethan Allen Express* routes.
- TrainCatcher van/car service available from Ft. Edward to Glens Falls and Lake George Village. Reservations required. Call (518) 792-1086 for information and reservations.
- From May 26-September 3, all passengers traveling through Albany-Rensselaer, NY on Train 64 will need to walk across the platform to change trains.
- On Saturday, May 26 only, Trains 63 and 69 will depart from New York Penn Station instead of Grand Central Terminal.
- * Connecting Train 291 operates Monday through Thursday; Connecting Train 255 operates Friday; and Connecting Train 295 operates Saturday and Sunday at different times than those shown. Please consult Amtrak.com.

*INFRASTRUCTURE RENEWAL AT NY PENN STATION

Amtrak will continue its Infrastructure Renewal program at New York Penn Station during Summer 2018 by performing critical reconstruction of three major railroad infrastructure assets in New York City: The Empire Tunnel and the Spuyten Duyvil Bridge, which provide train access between Upstate New York and New York Penn Station, as well as renewal work on Track 19 in New York Penn Station, which will help provide commuters with more reliable service. From May 26 through September 4, select Amtrak trains will utilize Grand Central Terminal instead of New York Penn Station for all service to and from New York City. Amtrak will not be providing substitute transportation between Grand Central Terminal and New York Penn Station. Directional maps with information on how to transfer between New York Penn Station and Grand Central Terminal can be found at the Customer Service kiosk at New York Penn Station.
