WESTERN ILLINOIS HISTORY

Take Amtrak for a fun getaway to historic Galesburg. Galesburg's Amtrak station is the cornerstone of the South Seminary Street Historic District, with its Railroad Museum, charming shops, antiques and dining. Enterprise Rent-A-Car is next to the station and the rest of downtown is just a few blocks away. Hotels and B & B's are available. Other interesting sites to visit within walking distance are the Discovery Depot Children's Museum, Galesburg Civic Art Center, Carl Sandburg State Historic Site, the Orpheum Theatre, and Knox College's Old Main where a Lincoln/Douglas debate took place.

Chicago Transit Authority (CTA) rapid transit trains provide frequent service to O'Hare and Midway Airports. Blue Line trains to O'Hare leave from the subway station at the corner of Clinton and Congress Streets, two blocks south of Union Station.
