Possible Lincoln Service Schedule Adjustment

During 2014, schedules may be temporarily adjusted to allow the State of Illinois to continue upgrading the Chicago-St. Louis corridor for 110 MPH service.

Trails and Rails Program: In cooperation with the National Park Service, volunteer rangers from the Jefferson National Expansion Memorial provide a narrative daily on Trains 301 and 302 between St. Louis and Springfield, May 28 through September 2, and weekends (Saturday and Sunday), September 7 through November 24. Volunteer rangers from the Lincoln Home National Historic Site provide narrative between Chicago and Springfield on Train 302 on select weekend days May 23 through October 26. 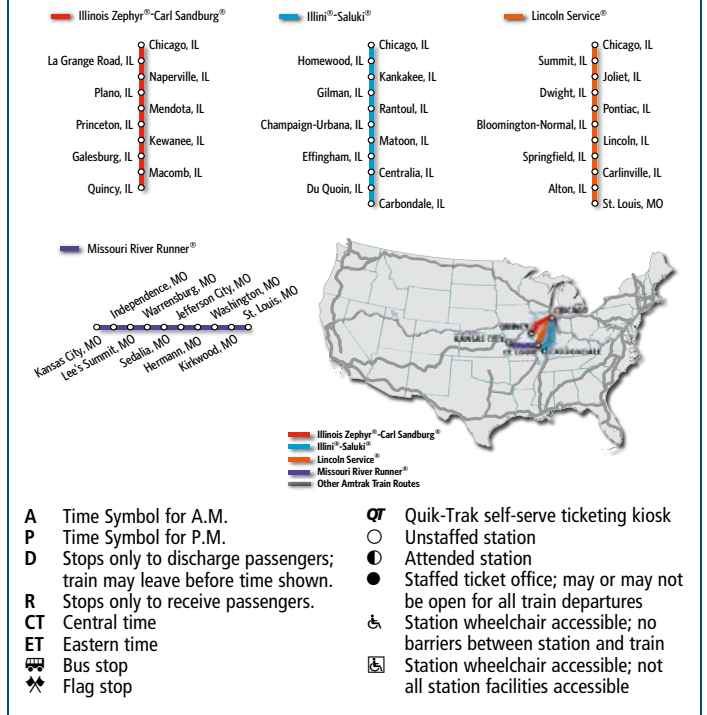
Connecting Local Services
