## Wilmington Station Renovation Begins

Starting this Spring, Amtrak and the Delaware Department of Transportation will begin a multi-year project to restore and renovate the historic Wilmington, Delaware station. Originally constructed in 1907, the Wilmington station is listed on the National Register of Historic Places and is one of the busiest Amtrak stations in the nation.
