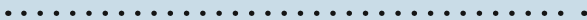

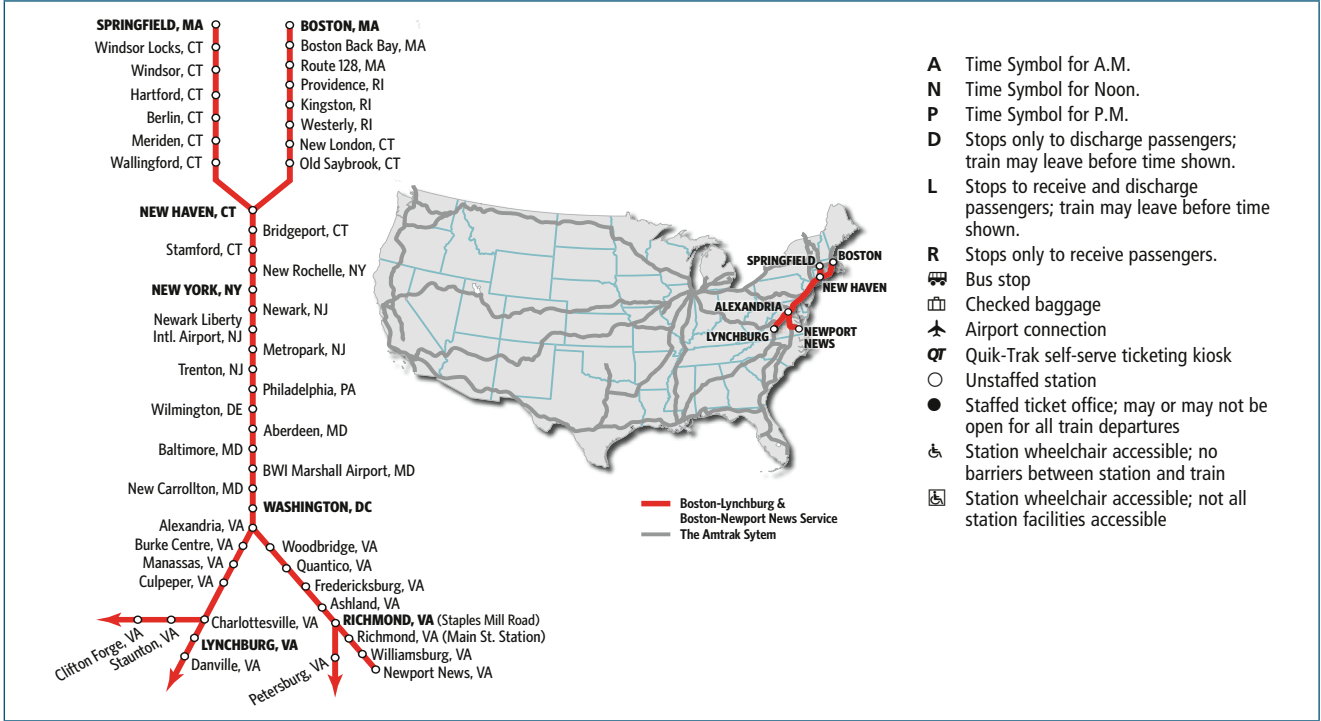

Service on Northeast RegionalSM

- Coaches: Reservations required.**
- Business class service available.
- Sandwiches, snacks and beverages.
- Amtrak Quiet car. Not available on Shuttle trains.
- Wi-Fi available.
- Saturdays and Sundays, Train 67 operates about 10 minutes later departing Washington, DC to Newport News, VA.
- Train 195; change at Washington.
- Change at New York to Train 168 on Saturdays and Train 132 on Sundays.
- Change at New Haven to Train 146 on Saturdays and Train 432 on Sundays.
- * Train 82 will operate Washington to Boston only 2/19.

Smoking is prohibited.

Service on the Cardinal[®]

- Coaches: Reservations required.**
- Sleeping cars:** Viewliner sleeping accommodations.
 - Amtrak Metropolitan Lounge/ClubAcela available in New York, Philadelphia, Washington and Chicago, for Sleeping car service passengers.
- Dining:** Combined Diner/Lounge provides food and beverage service.
- On Sundays, Train 50 and 51 operate up to ten minutes later at this station.

Service on the CarolinianSM

- Coaches: Reservations required.**
- Business class service:** Complimentary non-alcoholic beverages, newspaper and pillow, offered between New York and Charlotte.
- Dinette:** Sandwiches, snacks and beverages.
- Wi-Fi available.
- On Saturdays and Sundays, Trains 80 arrives New York at 8:49 p.m.

Service on the Crescent[®]

- Coaches: Reservations required.**

- Dining:** Full meal service.

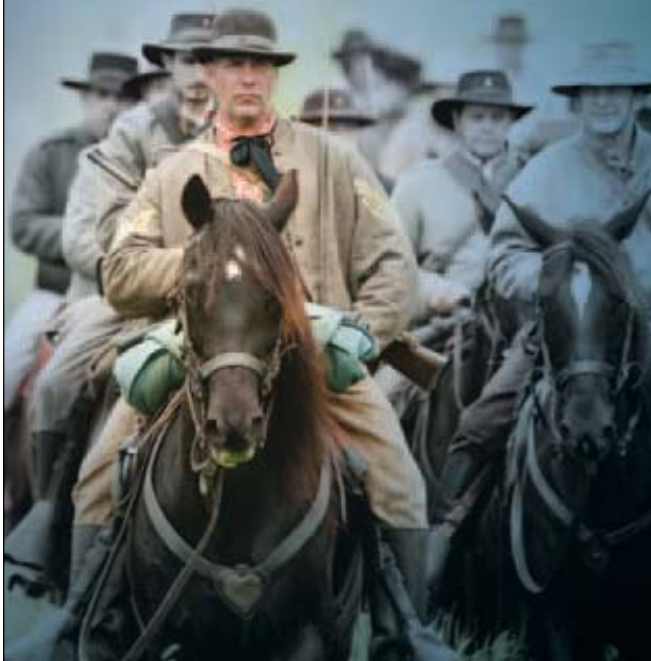
