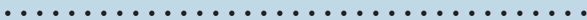

### Service on Northeast Regional<sup>SM</sup>

- Coaches: Reservations required.**
- Business class:** Complimentary non-alcoholic beverages and newspaper.
- Sandwiches, snacks and beverages.
- Amtrak Quiet car. Not available on Shuttle trains.
- Checked baggage at select stations.
- Wi-Fi available.
- Saturdays and Sundays, Train 67 operates about 10 minutes later departing Washington, DC to Newport News, VA.
- Train 195; change at Washington.
- On Saturdays, change at New York to Train 168; on Sundays, change at New York to Train 132.
- On Saturdays, change at New York to Train 146; on Sundays, change at Washington to Train 132, thence at New Haven to Train 432.
- \* On 7/4, Train 82 operates Richmond to New York only; on 5/27 and 9/2, Train 82 operates Washington to Boston only.

- Dining:** Combined Diner/Lounge provides food and beverage service.
- Checked baggage at select stations.
- On Sundays, Train 51 operates up to ten minutes later at this station.

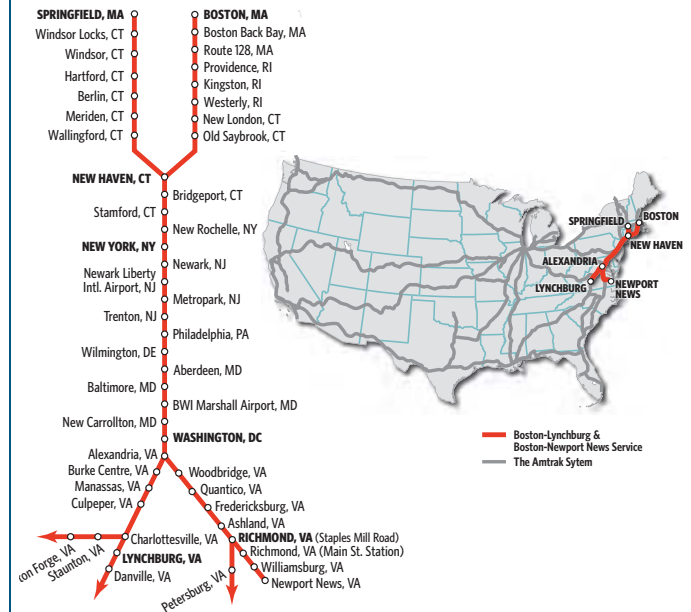
