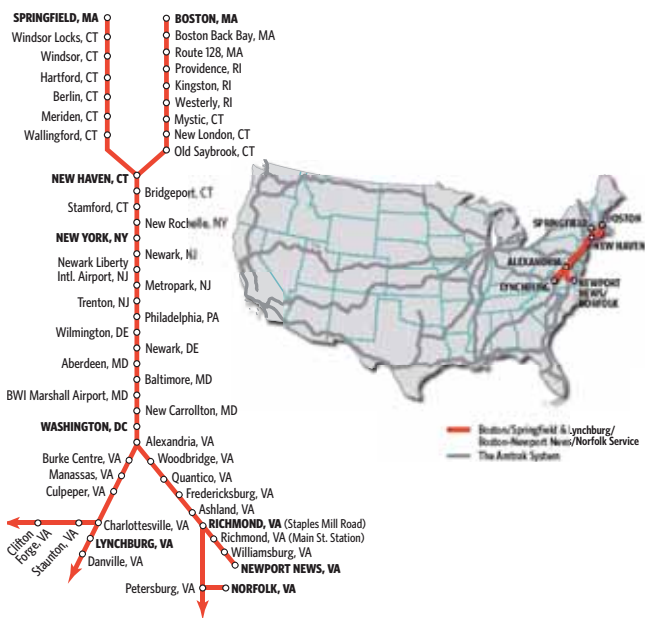
### Amtrak 30th Street Station-Center City Rail Transfer
